Ephesians 4:1-6 "Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God.<sup>2</sup> Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love.<sup>3</sup>

Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace. <sup>4</sup> For there is one body and one Spirit, just as you have been called to one glorious hope for the future.<sup>5</sup>
